Winner of the prestigious Leopold Mozart and Paganini competitions, Isabelle Faust has appeared with the world's leading orchestras, including the Berlin Philharmonic, Boston Symphony Orchestra, NHK Symphony Orchestra Tokyo, Freiburg Baroque Orchestra, and the Chamber Orchestra of Europe. 2016 marked her first year as Artistic Partner for the Mahler Chamber Orchestra.

Recent highlights include Ms. Faust's performances with the orchestras of Chicago and Cleveland, and a U.S. tour with Les Violons du Roy which included concerts at Walt Disney Concert Hall, Kennedy Center, and Carnegie Hall. In addition to her mastery of the great symphonic violin concertos, Faust also performs works such as Kurtág's "Kafka Fragments" with soprano Anna Prohaska, or Schubert's octet on historical instruments. She will premiere several new works for violin and orchestra during the next seasons, including concerti by composers Ondrej Adamek, Marco Stroppa, Oscar Strasnoy, and Beat Furrer.

Her recording of Bach's harpsichord sonatas with Kristian Bezuidenhout will be released in March 2018.
